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1. COURSE INFORMATION

1.1 GENERAL

The Directorate General of Training (DGT) under Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship offers a range of vocational training courses catering to the need of different sectors of the economy/ labour market. The vocational training programs of short term duration are intended for up skilling of NTC/ NAC pass out candidates. After passing out of the course, the trainee is awarded a competency based certificate approved by DGT.

During 12 Week duration of 'Professional Make-up and Hair stylist' course, a candidate trained on Professional Skills, Professional Knowledge. The broad components covered under Professional Skill subject are as below: The trainee learns to Understand and Recall the Hygiene Procedures and Brush Care; Carryout facial skin care treatment to enhance facial skin condition; Provide Make-up Services; Create looks using make up techniques; Carry out different styling techniques to complement Make Up.

1.2 PROGRESSION PATHWAYS

- Can join as a freelance Make-up Artist/ Hair Stylist in Industry and will progress further as make-up trainer, Centre head saloon, Beauty & wellness quality assurer and can rise up to the level of Manager.
- Can become Entrepreneur in the related field.

1.4 ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION



The trainee will be tested for his skill, knowledge and attitude during the period of course through formative assessment and at the end of the training programme through summative assessment as notified by the DGT from time to time.

- a) The Continuous Assessment (Internal) during the period of training will be done by Formative Assessment Method by testing for assessment criteria listed against learning outcomes. The training institute has to maintain an individual trainee portfolio as detailed in assessment guideline.
- b) The pattern and marking structure is being notified by DGT from time to time. The learning outcome and assessment criteria will be the basis for setting question papers for final assessment.
- c) Assessment will be evidence based comprising the following:
 - Job carried out in labs/workshop/Field
 - Answer sheet of assessment
 - Viva-voce
 - Participation and punctuality

Evidences of internal assessments are to be preserved until forthcoming Block examination for audit and verification by examining body.

d) The minimum pass percentage for skill test is 60%.



2. JOB ROLE

Brief description of Job roles:

Makeup Artist - A Make-up Artist job should contain the following duties and responsibilities: Communicate with clients to understand their needs and wants. Determine necessary supplies and equipment needed. Apply makeup in a professional manner. Pay attention to other details such as costumes and design. Help in applying and removing makeup and prosthetics. Work with other crew members. Examine makeup materials at disposal and chose the best option. Prepare budget planning for makeup supplies and tools. Track expenses. Keep makeup tools and products in check. Adhere to personal hygiene standards. Stay up to date with latest best practices, tools and technology in their field.

Hair Stylist; specializes in dressing hair according to latest style, period, or character portrayal, following instructions of patron MAKE-UP ARTIST, or script: Questions patron or reads instructions of MAKE-UP ARTIST or script to determine hairdressing requirements. Studies facial features of patron or performing artist and arranges, shapes, and trims hair to achieve desired effect, using fingers, combs, barber scissors, hair-waving solutions, hairpins, and other accessories. Dyes, tints, bleaches, or curls or waves hair as required. May create new style especially for patron. May clean and style wigs. May style hairpieces.

Beauticians and Related Workers, Others; Hairdressers, Barbers, Beauticians and Related Workers, other include all other hairdressers, barbers, beauticians and related workers not elsewhere classified.

Freelance Make-up artist- Freelance Makeup Artists are independent contractors who work on a variety of settings, such as photo shoots, occasional make up bookings etc. Some essential skills for this job are makeup techniques expertise, creativity, attention to details, time management, and strong communication and interpersonal skills.
